 appointed for all men once to die and being in a perfect and sound mind &
 memory do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner
 following - My Soul I give to God who gave it being Relying on the
 merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ for my salvation & my Body to be
 decently Intred after the manner of our Society, and in regard to the
 worldly Goods it hath pleased God to bestow on me I dispose of as
 follows - viz - I bequeath that all my real estate be sold

 my Grand Son Wellington Sims the sum of three Shillings. Item, I

 It is my will and desire that all my Estate be sold and the money arising
 from be equally Divided among my living Children, after paying my
 Son John Swanison the sum of fifteen pounds, or a Horse, Saddle
 bridle to that amount, should he live to the age of twenty one year
 and should he die before he arrives to that age it is my desire that
 such Legacy should be given him. It is my desire also that my

 I do constitute my Son Howel Sims & my son in Law John Nicholas
 & my friend Thomas Washington Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament. Declaring this to be my last Will and revoking all
