and certain that my last will and testament being pending all former be-
liefs or made or supposed and in testimony of this to my last will and
testament I hereby first of all recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty
God the Father & ever thereof trusting for happiness through the merits of Jesus
Christ my saviour and my body to be decently buried in a Christian manner at
the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named and after the payment of all
my just debts and funeral Charges my will and desire that the survivor of
my worldly estate which it hath pleased God & his goodness to bestow on me
be disposed of in the following manner (to wit) I Will & direct
that my wife Mary Harrison keep all my estate together untill all my just
debts be paid by the profits arising therefrom after which so as my desire is
that my estate shall be disposed of as follows (to wit) I Will & direct that my
beloved wife Mary Harrison the land which I have been possessed of
hundred forty seven acres be it the same more or less situate in the town of
Tuttha, Canton Litchfield, State of Ohio and in the future
income during her natural life. I Will & direct that my
son John Harrison the land which I purchased of John Smith lying &
lying on the east side of the Little Creek containing one hundred acres
be it the same more or less to him and his heirs forever. I Will & direct
and bequeath to my son Thomas Harrison one hundred acres of land
beginning at John Parners corner on Washington road and thence
the said Parners line so far as to include the stream known as
the dwelling house to him and his heirs forever. I Will & direct
to my sons Mark Harrison and James Harrison all the rest of my land
to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever
I Will & direct and bequeath to my son Henry Harrison one acre &
yearling also six & 75 acres of Land lying above his land on pole Creek
I Will & direct to my said wife Mary Harrison all the balance of my stock
of Cattle Hogs, Sheep & Horses with all my household & Fitchew Farm here
plantation interests & all the balance of my estate if any there be not mentioned
in this will. I Will & direct that the negro and other estate
but to my wife in this will except the land given to Mark James & Thomas
Harrison whatever remains at the death of my wife be equally divided
amongst all my children (to wit) John Harrison, William Harrison
Henry Harrison James Archer, Sabella Bellows, Mark Harrison
Nathan Harrison James Harrison, Thomas Harrison
and Elizabeth Harrison & their heirs forever.
