 five shillings to her then her heirs forever. My desire is after my decease
 that the remainder part of my estate shall be sold and the money equally
 divided among my Eight Children Viz: Nathan, Thomas, Sarah, Martha
 Amy, Anny, Mansfred, & Lucy Moseley to them & their heirs forever
 And lastly I do hereby appoint Nathan Moseley, Thomas Burnett &
 John Whitley as whole & sole Executors of this my last Will Testament
 Ratifying & confirming this then other to be my last Will Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
 25th day of December Seventeen hundred & twenty five
