William Gee In the name of God amen William Gee of the County of
Brunswick and Parish of Mcherrin do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following revoking all other Wills by me made, Item I give and
bequeath to my son John Gee, all that tract of land on which he now lives also one
negro woman named Frank, to him and his heirs forever, Item I give unto my son
in law Ephraim Parker, one negro man named Samuel to him and his heirs forever.
Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary boller one negro woman named Uppy
and her increase to her and her heirs forever, Item I give unto my Grand daughters
Tabithy Rivers and Judy Rivers one negro Girl named Winny and her increase to be
equally divided between my said Grand daughters when the eldest shall arrive at
the age of sixteen years old, Item I give unto my daughter Susan Roffer, every
thing I formerly lent except the negro Girl Winny already given to her two
daughters Tabithy Rivers and Judy Rivers Item I give unto my son William Gee
all that tract of land on which he now lives bounded by Mcherrin River on the
South as also one negro boy named Adam, to him and his heirs forever, Item
I give unto my Daughter Penelope Porter one negro woman named Clarissa
with her increase to her and her heirs forever, I give unto my daughter Bridget
Davis one negro Girl named Edy, to her and her heirs forever, Item I give
unto my son Joshua Gee, one negro man named Jerry, and one negro boy named
Edmund, as also one tract of land lying in the County of Mecklenburg, formerly
the property of Stephen Strange as also one tract of land in North Carolina
which land I purchased of Dennis Bradley, Item I give and bequeath

to my daughter Eliza Garrison one negro woman named Nancy to her and her
heirs forever, Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Gee all the land
lying on the south side of Mcherrin River in the County of Brunswick

after the death of my wife Isabell^t paying my son James fifty pounds
as soon as he shall arrive at the age of twenty one Item it is my will and
desire that my executors hereafter to be mentioned do as equally as possible
divide all the remainder of my estate amongst my three children Isabell^t
my daughter Nancy, my son James and my daughter Patty after paying
all my just debts and funeral expenses as they arree at the age of twenty one
year or more — Item it is my will and desire that the profits arising
from my tool bridge be equally divided between my two sons William & James
Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my son John Gee and my son
William Gee Executors to this my last Will & Testament Signed sealed acknow-
ledged and declared as my last act and deed this 11th day of October 1790.

This last Will and Testament of William Gee did^r was proved
by the oaths of John Jones Mary Ingram and John Marshall, witnesses thereto

Executors therein named. They having made oath thereto according to law and
together with Edward Pickrell and Asa Gresham, their securities entered into
and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds with
condition as the law directs Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate
thereof in due form
