being in sound Mind & Memory do make & ordain this to be
my last Will and Testament, in manner & form as follows
Item I give unto my beloved Wife Mary Warwick all the
Tract of Land I now live on containing three Hundred and
thirty Seven & one Quarter Acres To her and her Heirs & Af-
signs forever also her choice of three of our best feather beds
also after my Just debts are paid I leave unto my said
Wife all the residue of my Estate during her life to sup-
port & Educate my Children on, Except a Tract of Land
lying in Mecklenburg County in partnership between
Benjamin Williamson & myself, that I wish to be sold
for the payment of my Debts and at the death of my said Wife
that part of my estate lent her to be equally divided be-
tween my then surviving Children &c
And lastly I do constitute & appoint my friend John Camp
& John Blair as my Executors to this my last Will &
Testament recording all other Wills heretofore made

by me as Witness my Hand & Seal this 16 day of January 1796
