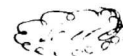


give her the said Mary C Robinson one equal third part of said

 my & my wife's house and lastly I constitute my said wife Rebecca
 Robinson my executor & John Robinson my executor to the next best
 will & testament making all others by me made as contrary my hand &
 seal this 27 day of May 1812
