 and future increase; and I promise they pay at the death of my loving wife
 Lucy Mallin half the value of Sabina and her children. I may then have to my
 daughter Amy Black, it is my will and desire that they the said Joseph Saunders and
 Patsy his wife have the said Patsy and her children and their future increase together with
 two beds and furniture now in their possession to them and their heirs forever. Item I

give and bequeath to my son Francis Mallin the land and plantation whereon I now live
 together with my adjoining lands; also the following slaves viz: David, Anthony, Carter,
 Claiborne, Charles, Cyrus, Sarah, Cynthia, Nancy, Albert, Matthew, Sucky, Molly and Sally
 with their present and future increase; also half my stock of cattle, sheep and hogs on
 half my sitting chairs and tables and those of my stock; and the chairs and tables just
 named which may remain at the death of my loving wife; two hogs of equal value
 with any two of my stock; two beds and furniture, one desk and book-case, and
 one case and bottles to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to

my son Nathaniel Mallin the land I have deeded to him and the following slaves
 viz: Bob, Cyrus, Jimmy, Isaac, Will, George, Luma and Mary with their present and
 future increase; together with all the other property now in his possession to him
 and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Amy Black

the following slaves viz: Arthur, Sarah, Dawson, Sally, Francis and Cyrus with
 their present and future increase; also half the value of Sabina and her children
 as above directed; with two beds and furniture now in his possession to her & her heirs
 forever. Item It is my will and desire that at the death of my loving wife my

son in law John Lewis, and Lucy his wife and my son in law John Hancock
 draw from my estate before a division each a sum adequate to half the value of
 Sabina and her children to them and their heirs forever. Item I stand unto my loving
 wife Lucy Mallin half the dwelling house and plantation whereon I now live and the

following viz: Sons Fountain, George, Rose, Jimmy, Sons Dinah, Liza, Polly, Park, Samuel
 Rachel, Sabina, Dick and Peter with their future increase; also the household and kitchen
 furniture, half my title together with every other piece of property of my estate which has

not before been divided; during his natural life. And at his death all the negroes
 which he has then disposed of as above; and other property but my said wife except the title

which is to return to Francis Mallin; be equally divided between James Mallin,
 John Hancock, John Davis and Lucy his wife Francis Mallin, Joseph Saunders and
 Patsy his wife Nathaniel Mallin & Amy Black to them & their heirs forever.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my sons in law John Hancock and Joseph
 Saunders Executors to this my last will and testament making void all
 former wills by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
