like manner Item my will and Desire is that all my
lawful debt be paid Item I lend unto my beloved wife
Susanna Vaughan one third part of my estate lands
Negroes and personal property during her life and at her death
to be Equally Divided amongst my Children Item I give
and Bequeath unto my son Robert Vaughan half of the
land in the State of Kentucky lying in Fayette County near
Lexington to him and his heirs forever providing he leaves an heir
Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Vaughan the other
half of the land in the State of Kentucky lying in Fayette County
near Lexington to him and his heirs forever providing he
leaves and heir. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Ben-
jamin Vaughan a part of the tract of land I Bought of
Benjamin Lanie's Estate att the lying East of Abram's branch
to him and his heirs forever Providing he leaves and heir
Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Vaughan
the land wheron I now live and the place West of Abrams
Branch also Two Negroes(townd) Mingo and Patty and a Twenty
pound piece horse to him and his heirs forever Providing he leaves
and heir. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna
Vaughan (Negroe townd) Nancy Siny Gordin Judy and
Tempy to her and her heirs forever Providing she leaves an heir
She is to receive them at the age of Twenty one Item I give
and bequeath unto my Daughter Salley Vaughan (Negroe
townd) Astor, Salley, Tabby, Sally and Hollon to her and her
heirs forever Providing she leaves and heir She is to receive
them at the age of Twenty one Item I give and bequeath
unto my Two grand Daughters Elizabeth M. Baff and
Patty Baff the sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds in

Money to be equally Divided between them both to them and
their heirs forever providing they leave and heirs to be kept in
hands of my executors till they arrive to the age of twenty one
Item I nominate and leave my wife Susanna Vaughan my
executrix and Robert Vaughan James Vaughan Kinchin,
Vaughan, and William Vaughan my executors no apraisement
of my estate if any of my children or grand children should
die without heirs lawfully begotten their legacies to return to the
survivors, at the death of my wife the balance of my Estate shall
be Equally divided amongst my six Children to wit, Robert
Vaughan, James Vaughan, Kinchin Vaughan & William Vaughan,
Susanna Vaughan and Sally Vaughan this my last will
and Testiment made this Twenty ninth day of August one
Thousand eight hundred and six

bond in the penalty of Forty thousand Dollars conditioned as
the law directs Certificate is granted them for obtaining letters
of administration on the Estate of the said testator with his
will annexed in due form
