 my just debts & funeral expenses be first paid out of my estate I give & bequeath unto
 my beloved daughter Mary Lightfoot One Negro woman named Patsy during her natural
 life but her estate to be valued by three persons to be named whom my two sons & my son
 John Lightfoot to have the said Negro woman named Patsy to have the same for ever
 I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Mary Lightfoot One Fourth part of
 my estate which she can live but her estate to be sold & the money to be equally divided
 between my two sons to them & their heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my
 beloved daughter Mary Lightfoot my two third part of my land which on her
 life during her natural life but her estate to be equally divided between my two sons
 John Lightfoot & Charles Lightfoot to them & their heirs forever I give
 & bequeath the residue of my land unto my two sons Charles Lightfoot & John Lightfoot
 equally to them & their heirs forever I give my Will & Testament is that my two sons & I
 having the residue of my estate equally among the two but her estate to be equally
 divided between my two sons to them & their heirs forever I give & bequeath
 my two sons Charles Lightfoot & John Lightfoot executor of this my last Will & Testament
 & the residue of all other debts & whatness I give & bequeath to be the last
 Will & Testament the 21st day of October 1806
