Item I give to my Daughter Martha Harris an girl brother an negro man Samuel and their future increase to her and her heirs forever Item I give to my Daughter Catharine an Woman Paulina & her child Charlotte an boy Jack an boy Dick an boy Hummition an Woman's saddle an Pan Mine for the use of my Daughter Catharine and Lucy if they shall be kept but if not sell her and divide the money you have to wit, Catharine her clothes trunk and their future increase to her and her heirs forever. Item I give to my son
