In the name of God amen I Richard Black of the County
of Brunswick being sick & weak in body but of sound mind memory do
humbly dispose by the following regulations of all my worldly goods Imprimis
I give & bequeath to my daughter Eliza Parsons Black the following.
Negroes bearing their six children together with their future increase
Sam Huston to her other heirs forever provided my said Daughter
Eliza should die without any lawful issue of her body then the above
Negroes with their men are shall return to my other children to be equally
divided between them or their heirs. And it is my further will & desire
that my Esq: horses after appointed shall give to my said Daughter
Eliza at the time of her marriage if her son should die before her
those to be worth two hundred Dollars. Item it is my will & desire
desire that my wife dispose setting aside of Woods & timber & money
of the others as they and their Negroes my wife & the use of
the family & Plantation. Item the last in my wife's right say Black
the whole of the rest to care of my Estate both real & personal
during the time of her widowhood & care until she shall marry again
until my son Frederick Martin Black & my younger Brother
arrive to the age of twenty one years in the event of either of these things
happening then to my wife Eliza. Item I give my say wife my
Negro Clark & his wife & their children but to her joint
heirs to enjoy in common the said Negro. Item it is my will & desire
settled between my six youngest children to them & their heirs forever. But
it is my will & desire that my wife have the said £1000 which is more
that the whole of my Lands including my wife's Hounds shall be taken
into the division. Item It is my will & desire that all the property leased
to my wife may share the same if her death, if a division soon not
take place before the equally divided between my six youngest
children to them & their heirs forever. Item It is my will that my
beloved wife may maintain & educate my six youngest children out of the
Estate left to her. Item It is my will and desire that all the money which
is due me as well as that which shall arise from the sale of my horses
after the payment of my just debts, should be put out to interest for the
benefit of my children but my Executor are authorized to apply a part or
the whole of the interest to the maintenance and Education of my six
youngest children of the Estate heretofore but my wife is insufficient
for that purpose. Item It is my will and desire that my Negro man Peter
at the death of marriage of my wife Amy Black should ^{be} freed

by my Esq^r Henry I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Amy Black
& my friend Hunting Ruffin Executive Executors of this my last
will & Testament and do hereby revoke all former Wills or parts
of Wills. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
this second day of January 1806.
