I now give and bequeath to my son Joseph M'Nutt Bishop his widow & children the other of my plantation and land. Be it noted the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid to satisfy his debt concerning my plantation land & Charles Graham & John Bishop his heirs to his widow during her widowhood then to be equally divided after her death between Matthew Bishop & Samuel Bishop. Also the plantation wherein I now live after the death of my wife & the end of my three daughters single lives to be equally divided between my son Joseph M'Nutt Bishop two sons also am wife man named Jerry to him and his heirs forever.

I now give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Bishop one negro woman Jenny and one boy named Jack to her & the heirs of her Body, bread and my wish and desire that fifty pounds be raised out of my Estate for my deceased son Harmonia Bishop to be equally divided amongst his children it is my wish & desire that Letters to be sold and the money to discharge my just debts with and that the remainder part of my Estate after my just debts be paid to be equally divided among my children & to hereby constable and inform my son John Bishop Esqur to the my last will & Testament and do hereby revoke & annul any wills made all and every other will and wills heretofore made by me.
