Thomas Hobson of the County of Brunswick being old and weak and
approaching near to the end appointed for all men - And feeling
desirous to make some distribution of my worldly Estate do hereby make
this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following - (to wit)
I bequeath unto my beloved wife Jane Hobson the Land and Plantation
whereon I now live, with her choice of two negro men one woman one
girl & one boy of which I may die possessed together with one half of all
my Stock of every kind - all my house hold and kitchen furniture - all
my plantation utensils, and one half of my interest in the Hill during his
natural life or widowhood. Item 2 I give and bequeath unto my son
William Hobson the Land and plantation where he now lives, bought of James
Hunt and at his mother's death I give him the land, which I have bequeathed her
(bought of Jas. Sanders) to him and his heirs forever Item 3 I give and bequeath
unto my son Thomas Hobson the land and plantation whereon he now lives
together with my interest in the Hill to him and his heirs forever. - Item 4
It is my will and desire bequeathing division of my personal estate shall take
place that each of my daughters with Fatsy Hartwell and Elizabeth Pon-
son and my grand son Addison Powell shand have the sum of Five hundred dollars
but should any advancement in money have taken place to either of my
daughters or grandson prior to my death then and in that case it is my
desire that such advancement be considered as part of the Five hundred dollars
given each, and be deducted therefrom. - Item 5 It is my will and desire that
all the rest and remain of my estate be equally divided among all my children
and my grand son Addison Powell be drawing an equal part (being considered
as full of his mother's care) but with this exception that each again,
shall first account by valuation for the negro or negroes which they may
respectively have received. - It is my further will and desire that my grand
son Addison Powell together with the legacy which I have herein given him
remain with, and under the care and control of my son Thomas - and should
he die before Addison coming to the age of twenty one, in that case I commit the
charge to my son William Hobson - And it is my further desire and many
that whatsoever I may expend on Addison in board and tuition between the
present time and my death, shall be accounted for by him out the legacy above
given - And should my said grand son die without his lawfully begotin
of his own boy - then I desire that the part herein given him be equally
divided among all my children. Item 6 I give unto James Powell the
sum of Two dollars and a half to constitute residue and appoint my two
sons William & John my whole and sole executors to this my last will and
testimony whereof I have set my hand and affix my

The last will & testament of Thomas Gholson deceased made & pronounced by the oath of Daniel Dugger Jr. a witness thereunto and Peter Wyche another witness thereto being sworn deponeth that he believing the name of Peter Wyche subscriber to the said will as a witness to his proper & personal writing and that he doth not of his own self subscribe it thereto only he has of hear the said Gholson acknowledged the same but that heat this time had no recollection of either signing the said will or hearing of it acknowledged and the court being satisfied as to the proof thereof the said will is deemed to be record and in the notation of William Gholson one of the executors therein named to having made oath thereto together with Thos. Gholson and Joseph Saunay his son unto witness whereupon acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars with condition as the said will & testate in granting him for obtaining a probate thereof in due course of law being named he other executor to join in the said probate and in thenceforth to be

In the NAME OF GOD AMEN. I Wm. Cordle of Brunswick County being weak in body but of sound mind and memory to make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. - I give & leave unto my Daughter Barbara Davis five negroes to wit Isabell Estey - Hannah Mason and Peter otherwise one by house one leather bed and furniture during her life and after her death to the heirs lawfully begotten of her Body. I also give unto my son William Cordle the plantation wheron I now live and three hundred and fifty acres of land adjoining John Long & Elizabeth Clarke to him and his heirs forever. - Item I give unto my son Daniel Cordle two hundred and six acres adjoining Isaac Hulky to him and his heirs forever. - Item in my will and desire is that all the remainder of my estate not hitherto willed away to be kept together on the plantation wheron I now live until my son Daniel being to twenty one years of age - and then my desire is that an equal division of all my personal property to be made between my two sons William Cordle & Daniel Cordle and if either of my sons William Cordle or Daniel Cordle is without lawful heir my desire is that the surviving brother shall inherit all the estate of the deceased and desirous is that this be no appraisement of my Estate lastly I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Martha Cordle Executrix of my two sons William Cordle and Daniel Cordle Executrix of this my last will and Testament.
