named Sudah I have given & bequeathed unto my son David my largest new best Iron large
Larson & printer furnace I have given & bequeathed unto my daughter Lucy Williams one Negro
woman named Sarah I have given & bequeathed unto my daughter Mary Williams one Negro
boy named Betsy also a standing cupboard & a large butter
fat & a large plank Bed also one feather Bed Furniture I have given & bequeathed unto my
Daughter Betty Williams one Negro Girl named Esther I have given my Negro boy named
Dick to be sold & the money arising from his sale to be equally divided between my Daughters
Winney Lee & her children that is living when the money is divided I have given my
Negro man named Mingo to be sold & the money arising from his sale to be equally
divided between my Daughters Sarah & Maria then four youngest children I have given my
Daughter Sarah & Maria four small feather Beds I have given unto my Daughter Peggy Phillips
one large Dutch Oven one Dutch pot & my second largest bedstead I have given unto
my Daughter Peggy Phillips one Negro Girl named Hannah during her life & after
her death it is my desire that the said Girl should descend to my Grand daughter
Betty Parker Phillips I have given my Negro boy named Will to be sold & the
money arising from his sale for my Daughter Francis Ann's I have given unto
my youngest widow of Samuel Jackson her children Ten pounds each also one
fourth part of the money arising from the sale of Mingo to be equally divided
between them the remainder of my estate not already given away I wish to be sold
having just debts to be paid & the balance of the money to be equally divided
among all my children it is my desire that my estate should not be appraised

John Kelly This last Will Testament of Thomas Jackson dec^d was proved by the oaths of Isaac Williams of the witnesses thereto subscribed to be recorded and on the motion of John Ellis the executor therein named who made oath thereto according to law together with Hubbard Holt & Ephraim Jackson his securities entered into Acknowledgement Bond in the penalty of Five thousand Dollars with condition as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.

it was also proved by the witnesses thereto that the said Will was in October 1803
