Testament in manner form as follows that is to say I dost be my beloved wife Mrs
Manson during her natural life the following Negroes Charles Buck, Lucy, & Edward
Ellis, Sarah Solomon & their future increase that hereafter to be equally divided
between my six children Mary Baker Farley, Susannah Haraway Buford, Martha
Manson, Edward Manson, Agnes Thewatt, Manson & Thomas James Mansons
Also leave to my beloved wife the land & plantation that we now live on. Also I give
the third part of my stock & house hold furniture I give & devise to my Daughter Mary
Baker Farley & her heirs forever the said Negro Bill Amy small & their increase
I give & devise to my Daughter Susannah Haraway Buford & her heirs the following
negroes Nancy, Milly & Lewina & their increase I give & devise to my Daughter
Martha Manson & her heirs the following Negro Ben, Matilda & Eliza & their

increase I give & devise to my son Edward Manson his heirs the said Negroes Caesar
Sintoy & Allen & their increase. I give & devise to my Daughter Agnes Thrall
Manson his heirs the said Negroes Major, Easter, Billy & their increase.
I give & devise to my son Thomas James Manson his heirs the following Negroes
Jack, Soby & Patti & their increase And the tract of land that I now live on at
my wife Death I give & devise to my son Thomas James Manson I give & devise
to my son Edward Manson the tract of land I Bought of Henry Heatts Esq^r Except
one third part of the said mill I hand to my wife Ann Manson & her death
to my son Edward Manson I also give to my Daughters that is now unmarried
that when married or come to age agreeable to me about 85[£] to be furnished two Cows
Calves to be raised out of my Estate not before mentioned And at my wife death
all my Estate not before mentioned both real & personal to be equally divided between
my six children above mentioned also I appoint Edward Jones Farfley & Abraham Buford
my Executors to this my last will & testament in testimony whereunto set my hand
Seal this nineteenth day of October eighteen hundred & five.
