

I give unto my Daughter Nanny Moore the other half of my land and my two Negroes Lisa, and Minner to her and her heirs forever after the death of wife, also one feather bed which she is to take choice of all I have. I do hereby constitute appoint and ordain Benjamin Moore Nanny Moore and Richard Coleman whole and sole Executors and Executors of this my last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and seal hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of November 1863. -

This last Will & Testament of William Moore dec^d was proved by the Oaths of the Witnesses thereto ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Benjamin Moore one of the executors therein appointed he having made oath thereto according to Law & together with William H. Harper & Nathaniel Harper his securities entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars with condition as the Law directs to certify & grant him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form liberally being reserved the other executors therein named to join in the same probate when they think fit -
