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In the Name of God Amen I Bartholomew Proctor of
the Parish of Saint Andrews in the County of Brunswick being weak
in body but of a sound perfect Disposing mind and Memory thank be
given to God for the same, and having to mind the Mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for man once to die, do make
and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following hereby Revoking all other wills and Testaments by me here-
before made: **FIRST** I commend my soul unto the hands of God that
gavest and for my body I commend to the Earth to be buried in a decent
Christian manner by my Executors hereafter named and according to the
disposition of all such Temporal Estate as it hath been pleased
almighty God to bestow upon me I give, devise, dispose, thereof as
followeth: **IMMOVABLES** I will that my debt and funeral expences
be duly paid and discharged my will is: **FIRST** I desire that my
plantation maybe disposed of to pay my debts that lays on the North
side of the River. **ITEM** I give unto my son Sam Sarah willing one young
man upon bargain breake. **ITEM** I give and bequeath unto Daniel
Leagon one young man. **SHIRAZ** will be left to the

disposition of all such Temporal Estate and hath been pleased

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almighty God to bestow upon me I give, devise, dispose thereof as

followeth. **IN WITNESS** I will that — my debt and funeral expences

be duly paid and discharged my will is. First I desire that my

plantation maybe disposed of to pay my debts that lays on the North

side of the River. **Item** I give unto my son Sam. Sarah Miller one young

mare upon bargin break. **Item** I give and bequeath unto Daniel

Leagons one young mare Shuiger balls belts. for his Trouser. **Item**

I give and bequeath unto my son William Rowardes my Gun that shot

me when ever he is able to hunt. **Item** I give and bequeath unto my

wife Sarah Rowardes all my goods and chattels both real and

personal during her widowhood which are not herein before given and

disposed of and I do hereby name, name and appoint my Father in law

Benjamin Leagins and my Brother George Rowardes my full and sole

executors and executrix of this my last will and Testament. **In**

Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and put my Seal

this 19th day of December 1739.
