Executor of this my last Will and Testament as Witness my

into and acknowledged Bond in the penalty of two hundred
pounds with conditions according to Law and it was further
ordered that John Denton Esq^r be and he did

the Testator should be summoned to appear at the next Court to be held for the said County and contest the validity thereof if he should think fit
