

9. WILL OF FRANCES BRUMBLELOW. (No docket).

In the Name of God Amen, I Frances Brumblelow of the County of Brunswick being of perfect mind and of disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, to wit.

I give my Stock of Hogs, & Cows together with two Feather Beds
& furniture to be equally divided between James Fisher, and
John Fisher, together with all of my Estate both real and personal
which I have not before devised.

I nominate and appoint James Fisher & John Fisher Executors
to this my last will and Testament, revoking and disanulling
all others heretofore by me made.
