 of the County of Brunswick do make my Last Will and Testament
 in manner following In the first place I resign my soul unto the
 hands of Almighty God and my body to the Earth trusting and hoping in
 the infinite Merits of God for a Resurrection to Eternal Life through the
 Merits and Mediations of my Redeemed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
 As to my Mortal Estate which it has pleased God to bestow on me I will
 as follows I GIVE and Devise A bigal Negro man and to her heirs forever
 one Negro Fellow Named Jack and one Negro Woman Named Judy
 and one Negro boy Named Jacob and my Riding Saddle. I GIVE and
 Devise to my Daughter Rebecca Lucas and to her heirs forever one
 Negro Man Named Sam and Twenty five pounds Current Money
 one Well metal shilled and my handw bed with all the Furniture thereto
 belonging I GIVE and Devise to my son William Wyche and to his
 heirs forever one Negro Woman Named Coffey and one Negro Woman
 Named Repe and four Leather Chairs and my Great feather bed with
 the furniture thereto belonging I GIVE and Devise to my Daughter
 Elizabeth Lucas and to her heirs forever one Negro boy Named Tom of
 the feather bed and furniture thereon I Leave two Negro wenches

in a new following. In the first place I resign my soul unto the
hands of almighty God and my body to the Church trusting and hoping in
the infinite Mercy of God for a Resurrection to Eternal Life through the
Merits and Mediations of my Redeemed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
As to my Mortal Estate which it has pleased God to bestow on me I will
as follows **GIVE** and Devise A bigal Rumen and to her heirs forever
one Negro Fellow Named Jack and one Negro Woman Named Judy
and one Negro boy Named Isaac and my Riding Saddle. **GIVE** and
Devise to my Daughter Rebecca Lucas and to her heirs forever one
Negro Man Named Sam and Twenty five pounds Current Money
one Roll metal shilled and my bundle bed with all the Furniture thereto
belonging **GIVE** and Devise to my son William Wyche and to his
heirs forever one Negro Man Named Coffee and one Negro Woman
Named Rex and four Leather Chairs and my great feather bed with
the Furniture thereto belonging **GIVE** and Devise to my Daughter
Elizabeth Lucas and to her heirs forever one Negro boy Named Tom of
the feather bed and Furniture thereto. **SEAVE** Two Negro Wench
one Named Lucy and the other Susan the Care of my said Daughters
Elizabeth during her Natural Life provided my said Daughter

as pay and Delivered to my Grandson William Lucas Son of Samuel &
Rebecca Lucas for her to own the first Young Negro that shall be
raised by either of these said Wenchers to be given I mean said and my Will
is that at the Death of my said Daughter the two wenchers and their
Increase except the Young Negro directed to be given and Delivered
to my Grandson as is above mentioned to be Equally divided
between such Children as shall be then Living of the Elizabeth
but if the said Elizabeth shall leave no Child or Children at the
time of her Death then and in such Case I order that the said two
wenchers and their increase be Equally Divided between my other
three Children already Named or their Heirs Provided nevertheless
that if my son in Law William Lucas should depart this Life before
my said Daughter Elizabeth that she become a Widow then and in
such Case the above divisions to be void and the two wenchers above
directed to be divided and their increase except the Young Negro above
excepted hereby directed and my Will is that they shall become
the absolute property of my said Daughter separate from the Estate
or encumbrance of them the said William Lucas and his Heirs
Give to my Grandson John Kinner and to his Heirs one Negro
boy named Daniel Give to my Grand Daughter Frances Kinner

boy named **Samuel Gove** to my Grand Daughter Frances Brewer
 one feather bed **Soder** that my wearing cloaths and my slays &
 shavers be Equally divided between my three Daughters and that
 after the payment of my Debts and Funeral Expences the
 Remainder of my Estate be Equally divided by three persons to be
 appointed ^{by my self} William Wyche and my son in Law George Brewer I
 also appoint my son William Wyche and my son in Law George
 Brewer Executors of this my Last will and Testament I also order and
 direct that there shall be no appraisement of my Estate in Wm
 whereof I herunto set my hand the 11 Day of April 1757
