Item I lend to my wife Catharine Chambers all my Real & Personal Estate during
her natural life & after to be equally divided between my two Daughters Mary
& Rody & their heirs forever. And I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife
Catharine Chambers whole & sole Right to this my last Will & Testament
only reading over and Examining all Wills made by me
bearing the 11th/12th day of May in the

year 1786 in the presence of my friends & neighbors.
