of what Nature or kind soever and her dower or Marriage to be equi-
divided between my two Sons John & William. **AND** I likewise
do hereby declare is that all my Part of what kind or Nature soever
I have remain continuing in the Hands of my Executors here after re-
mains then by the Profits arising from the said Estate have satisfied
and paid all my Just Debt and then to be disposed of in manner

I have remaind continuall in the Hands of my Executors hereof his name
 until they by the profits arising from my said Estate have satisfied
 and paid all my Just Debts and then to be disposed of in manner
 as above I have directed. And lastly I constitute & appoint Robert
 Thornton whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Test
