I give and bequeath unto my son James Sunday one Tract of Land containing
two hundred acres more or less lying and being on the South of Sackwamy
in the Township of North Carolina the Land he now lives on to him and
his heirs and assigns forever And Likewise give and bequeath to my
son James Sunday all my Stock of hogs and Cattle belonging to the said
Plantation that he hath now in his possession to him and his heirs for ever
And I Likewise give my said son James all my Treasures both in the

I Give and Bequeath unto my two Sons Simon Sunday and Daniel
 Sunday the Plantation and Land that I now live on containing one
 hundred and eighty Acres to be Divided between them in manner and
 form as follows to make a line a Crope from Sister Pines to Court's line
 above the plantation and the Lower part for Simon and the upper part
 for Daniel to them and their heirs and assigns forever. And I likewise
 give my two Sons Simon and Daniel Sunday a Mare a piece to them and
 their heirs and assigns forever. I Give and bequeath unto my
 Beloved Wife Sarah Sunday my Negro Sellow Named Brister and my
 Riding Horse and his own Riding Saddle and a new feather bed and Furniture
 and one Iron pot the Largest I have to her and her heirs and assigns for
 ever. I Give and Bequeath my Son Samuel Sunday one Horse
 called by the Name of his and one Feather Bed and Furniture and one Iron
 pot each called by the name of his to him and his heirs forever. I Give
 and bequeath unto my Son Abraham Sunday my Riding Saddle
 the Mare and foals that I bought of Abraham Johnson one feather bed
 and furniture and one Iron pot to him and his heirs assigns forever.
 I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Winifred Sunday one two
 Year old mare I bought of Mr. St.

and bequeath to my Daughter Winifred Sunday one two
Pear old mare bought of Jonathan Johnson and his Son Peter and
one Penkw Brown to her and her heirs for ever. **Item** Give and bequeath
unto my Exor all my Goods and Chattels both real and personal which are
not herein before given and Disposed of to Discharge my Debt and Funeral
expences with and after my Debt is Complied with and there be any of
the said Goods and Chattels be left more then Discharge my Debt to be
Equally Divided between my Wife and Children except my Son James &
Sister by. Nominate and appoint my Beloved Wife Sarah Sunday &
my Son James Sunday my full and sole Executors of this my Last
Will and Testament **In Witness** whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Affixed my Seal this 16th of September In the Year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and forty four.
