made first I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of
the almighty who gave it and my body to be Decently
buried according to the Discretion of my Executrix and
for what World Good it hath pleased God to bestow on
me I give and bequeath as followeth. Item I give and
bequeath unto my well Beloved Brother William Brooks
all my wearing close unto him and his heirs for ever. Item
I give all the Rest of my Estate both Real and Personal
unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth Brooks and her heirs or
Assigns for ever and that my wife give no security nor my

Assigns forever and that my wife give no Security nor my
Estate shall not be appraised and I do constitute and
appoint my Loving wife Elizabeth Brooks my whole and
sole Executrix of this last will and Testament In Witnes
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
This seventeenth Day of December 1750.
