and bequeath to my Grandson John Lucas one hundred Acres
of Land adjoining to my Son Joseph's Land already bequeathed

Loving Wife Judith Park be the whole and sole executrix of
this my last Will and Testament revoking and disannulling all

December in the year of our Lord MDCCXLVI.
