The undersigned Commissioner respectfully
reports to the County Court of Brunswick that he has in obedience
to the foregoing order stated, settled and adjusted the account
of Thomas A. Sholom as the Guardian of Miss Ann Eliza Hill. It is de-
cided on the 1st day of July 1861 and exhibits a balance on that day,
in the hands of the said Guardian, of £224.4s. Proper and salar-
factory vouchers were produced for all the disbursements.

In arranging the account itself, the Commissioner has taken no notice
of the fact that the disbursements have exceeded the profits of the
estate; and the amounts authorized by the Court to be expended
out of the principal. To put that matter right he has relied up-
on the following special statement, made at the instance of the
Guardian, and which he submits as a part of his report -

It thus appears that there is an unauthorised diminution of the
principal of the ward's estate of £075.44. The Guardian is by law
accountable for this amount, and Miss Hill when she attains the
age of twenty one years, or her husband, should she marry, may
hold him responsible for the same.

In this account the Guardian has accounted for the £500 be-
queathed by Mrs Mary Sholom to R. M. Hill upon his attaining there-
by one year. He did reach that age, but died soon after. Miss
Ann C. Hill was his only sister or brother, and the Guardian who was
the Adm't. of Mrs Mary Sholom, without any qualification on R. M.
Hill's estate accounts with Ann C. Hill for the whole of Mrs Mary
Sholom's estate.
