In the name of God Amen I Richard Ramsey of Brunswick
County being of perfect mind and Memory thanks be to Almighty God
for the same do make this my last will and Testament in manner &
form following first I recommend my Soul to Almighty hoping through
the intercession of my ever blessed saviour it will be received and my body to
the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named and as to my worldly Estate I dispose of in the following manner
Item My will and desire is that my well beloved wife Elizabeth
Ramsey shall have the use of my whole Estate Personal and Real
during her life and at her decease the negroes sold and the money
equally divided among all my Children that is then alive except
my daughter Elizabeth all the rest of my Estate I desire may be sold
and the money equally divided between my Children I my wife
Elizabeth

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Children that is then alive except my Daughter Elizabeth

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Elizabeth. Now I give to my daughter Elizabeth five shillings &
no more. Lastly I Nominate & Appoint my wife Elizabeth Hamsey
& my son Richard Hamsey to be my whole & Sole Executors of this my
last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my Seal this 6th day of May 1784.
