 marriage and then have their Estate in their own Hands

use of my Land as long as she lives my Widow and at
her marriage I desire my Land in a full fold and the
Money arising from the sale be equally divided among
my four Daughters above mentioned And I do appoint
my loving Wife Executrix of this my last Will and
Testament provided she prove the Will in three months
after my decease and if she neglects to prove it by the
time above mentioned I do appoint my Brother William
Barnett of Fairfax County Executor of this my last Will
and Testament revoking and annulling all other
Wills heretofore made whereunto I have set my hand
and affixed my Seal this sixteenth Day of September
one thousand seven Hundred and fifty six
