In the name of God amen Thomas Mitchell of Brunswick County
in Mahavien Parish do make this my Last will and Testament in
Manner as followeth First I Commit my Body to the Earth and my
Soul to the almighty God, Next I give and bequeath unto Isum
Mitchell my Brother certain tract of Land containing one Hundred
and forty acres In Brunswick County in Mahavien Parish Situating
and lying of South Side of falling Run swamp to him and his Heirs
forever and the rest of my Goods Chattels I leave to be equally Divided
between my Brother Isum Mitchell aforesaid and Minniegrit Mitchell
my Sister after my decess also I will & appoint Isum Mitchell my
Executor in witness my Hand and Via my Seal the Thirtieth Day
May in the year of our Lord 1758.
