In the name of God Amen William Holloway of Brunswick County
being at this time in Right Mind & Memory and considering that all Men is
appointed one to die do make constitute & Ordain this my last Will and Testament
and as concerning such Worldly Goods as God hath blessed me with ^{in this world} I give &
Bestow in the following manner & form.

First, I Give unto my wife Martha Holloway the plantation & Land whereon I
now live Also four Negroes namely Charles, Swingum, Deacas & Susanna and two
horses, Ten cattle, fifteen Swine ten Sheep one Bed & Furniture one Chest and a
sufficiency of all sorts of Tools & household Furniture to support the said family above
mentioned with provision for one years support and after my Wifes death or Marriage
the Articles above mentioned to be equally divided into seven parts among my six
living Children and their Children Except the Land above lent which shall be
entirely reserved to my son Deac Holloway the sum of 389 Acres

Living Children and Obed's Children except the Land above first which shall be
mentioned hereafter. Also I give unto my son Dan Holloway the sum of 389 Acres
of my Land holding the plantation whereon he now lives to him and his heirs forever
Also I give unto my son Jesse Holloway the sum of my
389 Acres of my Land holding the plantation whereon he now lives also one Negro
named Jacob to him and his heirs forever. Also I give unto my son Upha Holloway
all the remainder part of my Land holding the plantation whereon I now live
also one Negro named German to him and his heirs forever. Also I give unto my son
Ezra Holloway one hundred pounds to be raised of my Estate all the remainder
part of my Estate that has not been already mentioned after each one's receiving
all the laws in possession shall be equally divided into seven parts among
my six ^{living} children and Obed's children; Obed's children is to have a seventh
part equally divided among them also I appoint my three sons Dan Holloway
Jesse Holloway and Upha Holloway Executors of this my last Will & Testament
and I do hereby utterly disallow every former Will or Wills by me heretofore made.

189 of my Land holding the plantation whereon I now live
I have given and bequeathed to my son Asa Holloway
all the remainder part of my Land holding the plantation whereon I now live
to one Negro named Simon to him and his heirs forever also I give unto my son
Asa Holloway one hundred pounds to be raised of my Estate all the remainder
part of my Estate that has not been already mentioned after each one's death
all the land in his possession shall be equally divided into seven parts among
my ^{living} six children (and Obed's children; Obed's children is to have a seventh
part equally divided among them) also I appoint my three sons Dan Holloway
Asa Holloway and Upha Holloway Executors of this my last Will & Testament
and I do hereby utterly disallow every former Will or Wills by me heretofore made
ratifying and confirming this to be my last will & Testament. In
witness whereof I and William Holloway have set my hand & Seal unto these presents
this 16 day of October 1784. And acknowledged this to be my Last Will and
