I Adocia Fome of said County and State being of sound mind and health do make this my last will and Testament and revoking all other heretofore made by me witness

1st After my just debts I may be owing at my death are first paid I will and give to my three children namely Mariah L Fome, Willie A Fome and Thomas L Fome all of my real and personal estate that I now possess or may have at my death including money and other personal effects except as follows

2^d I give to my son W^m A Fome \$200 Dollars two hundred dollars to be paid to him in five annual yearly instalments forty dollars \$40 per year without interest

3^d I will to W^m A Fomes & Tho^s L Fomes in trust for the benefit of my son Jno A Fome two hundred \$200 dollars the interest to be paid to him annually and at his death if without legal heir or heirs if there should be any residue of the above named trust fund unused then it reverts to M L Fome Willie A Fome and Thomas L Fome and further I desire and request of my three last named children above including W^m A Fomes that if at any time my son Jno A Fome should be sick and unable to care for himself they are to see that he does not suffer for want and also when he is not engaged in business from my present home he is after my death and as long as it remains in the possession of M L Willie A and Tho^s L Fomes to occupy a room and bed I hereby appoint and desire my two sons W^m A Fome and Tho^s L Fome Executors of this my will and I do not require any security

 This last Will and Testament of Adonias Jones, deceased, was read in
 Court, and proved by the oaths of H. H. Pryor and Wm. J. Dancy, the
 subscribing witnesses thereto, and orders to be recorded. And on the
 motion of Wm. A. Jones and Thomas L. Jones, the Executor named in said
 Will who made oath as the law directs, and entered into and acknowledged
 a bond in the penalty of \$1000. conditioned according to law
 without security, the testatrix by her Will directing that none should be
 required certificate is granted. The said Wm. A. Jones and Thomas L. Jones
 for obtaining a probate of the said Will "do for"

 of Buckingham and State of Virginia being of sound mind, and in good health,
 and desiring while in that condition to provide for the future, and being
 possessed of 500 Acres of land in the County of Buckingham a part of Elk
 Grove and being possessed of considerable personal and perishable property in
 the County of Buckingham now on said land and having the right to dispose
 of all of said property by last Will as if I the said Sarah Ann Driscoll
 were unmarried do make this my last Will and Testament as follows:

I give and bequeath to each of my children one eighth of my land
 and one eighth of all the personal property which may exist at my
 death, the steam engine, pictures and all appurtenances to be regarded
 as personal estate and to be so treated in the division. In making the
 division of my land the share of my children, Rosa Nora Driscoll, 11th 1890
