I Aron Agee of the County and State above mentioned being of sound mind and wishing to dispose of my earthly effects do make this my last Will and Testament.

1st My burial expenses are to be paid.

2^d My just debts are to be paid.

3^d I give and bequeath to my youngest daughter Fannie Gertrude Agee, the residue of my property, to wit: thirty acres of land more or less, lying in Buckingham Co. on Slate River, and bounded by the lands of Robert M. Ayres, and Ann Agee Jr. also my household furniture, farming implements, and whatever provisions or crop and stock I may own at the time of my death.

4th I do hereby appoint Henry Winn as my Administrator to carry out the provisions of this my last Will according to law.

5th In case my daughter Fannie Gertrude Agee should die without heirs I desire my estate to go to my other living children or their heirs. Witness my signature this 12th day of April 1881.
