Buckingham County

22 Apr 1820/....

All of my lands to be sold along with all of my stock plantation utensils, HF, KF, present crops and ... and the proceeds to be applied to the discharge of my debts ... the following negroes viz Gray and his wife Joanna, their two youngest children Paulina and Chester, negroes Isaac, Tone, Pamela, Maria, Philis and her youngest child Hannah, Sucky and her youngest child Archer and Eliza emancipated and set free by my Executors. To my brother Samuel Jones a negro boy Isham to serve him as a slave for twenty years and then to be set free. To my brother Thomas Jones two negroes Simon and Tone to serve him as slaves for twenty years and then to be set free. To my executors two slaves Carter and John with the profits of their work to go to my brother Josias Jones. The slave Carter to work for fifteen years and John for twenty years and then to be set free. My brother James Jones slaves Rose, Peter, Moses and Hannah the daughter of Sucky to be held as slaves for twenty years and then to be set free. My sister Polley Jones two slaves Judith and Matilda to be held for twenty years and then to be set free also a good horse and saddle. Five hundred dollars for the benefit of Spotswood Jones. The residue if there should be any to

Mary Elizabeth Jones, daughter of James Jones, my brother. Exors: My brothers Samuel Jones and James Jones and Archibald Austin. Wit: Archibald Austin, John Bagby and Marshall Wood.

Codicil. 25 April 1820. To my brother Thomas Jones a negro boy by the name of Campbell to be held as a slave for fifteen years and then liberated or set free. Witnesses: John Bagby, Arch^d Austin.
