

I, Elizabeth L. Lemen, do make and endorse this my last Will and Testament.

1 I give to L. B. Lemen one half of all my estate that I am now possessed of, or that may come to me hereafter.

2 I give the remaining half of all of my estate to my sister Virginia, the wife of Wm J. Olin, to be held by her during her natural life, and thereafter to the children of the said Virginia.

I hereby constitute and appoint said L. B. Lemen Executor of this my Will, and ask that the Court will not require any security of him.
