The said land Mr A. C. Barnett has had a deed of trust on for the benefit of Mr James A. Wright, and who has paid of the amount of money due on the said deed of trust except sixty dollars, which he has receipts to shew; If the said sixty dollars is not paid at the time of my death I wish a part of the rent taken to pay it, so that my sisters children may own the land without any difficulty about the title. Witness my hand and seal this 20th day of August, 1881.
