bequeath my estate and property as follows that is to say I give to
my oldest daughter Agnes H. Bryant and her heirs thirty acres of land
adjoining the lands of Andrew Steger, Dathlett and Moon. I give to
my son Henry C. Bryant in trust for his heirs fifty five acres of land
adjoining the lot of the heirs of Agnes H. Bryant. I give to my daughter
Ondarilla Staton and her heirs fifty five acres of land adjoining the lot
of Henry C. Bryant and Ballower's estate. I give to my son W. A. Bryant
in trust for his heirs eighty acres of land adjoining the lot of Henry C.
Bryant and the lands of W. T. Anderson and others. I give to my son
John H. Bryant the residue of my property both real and personal that
is to say the land on which I now reside containing eighty acres with
all my personal property In consideration of which he is to take

care of and support my beloved wife for so long as she may remain on the place as long as she live.

I appoint my son John N Bryant Executor of this my Will. In witness whereof I have signed and sealed, witnessed, published and declared this instrument my Will this 10th day of July 1882.
