namely Samuel, Charles and Pink. Should my daughter Pink die
without heirs I wish and order that her portion of the land shall
revert to her brothers Charles and Samuel. I further order that my per-
ishable property be sold and that one dollar be given to each of my
grand children, that is, the children of my deceased daughter Bethe and
Sucky, and the balance shall belong to the above named living child-
ren. I do hereby appoint and constitute my son Samuel Seay my
Executor to this my last Will and Testament.

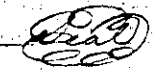
