

I Jane D. Molloy of the County of Buckingham and State of Virginia, hereby revoking all other and former wills heretofore made by me, ordain this writing to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say -

Item 1st I direct that all my just debts shall be paid.

Item 2^d I give to my daughter Mary C. Gannaway, the wife of Richard M. Gannaway, my tract of land called Red Oak containing eight hundred acres, lying in the said County of Buckingham together with all the personal property that may be on the same at the time of my death, for the sole and separate use of my said daughter, free from the control, debts or contracts of her husband the said Richard M. Gannaway. And the said Mary C. Gannaway shall have the power to dispose of the said tract of land and property in her lifetime, by deed or other writing, as she may think proper, or by last Will and Testament as she may direct and appoint. And in the event that she shall make no such disposition of said tract of land and personal property, the same shall, at her death, descend and pass to her children living at her death and the descendants of such of them as may be dead, according to the statute of descents and distribution of the State of Virginia, or if the said Mary C. Gannaway has survived her husband and dies intestate.

Item 3^d I give to my daughter Sarah K. Clark wife of Archibald Clark my interest in a tract of land called Burfords lying in the said County of Buckingham for the sole and separate use of my said daughter, free from the control, debts or contracts of her husband, the said Archibald Clark. And the said Sarah K. Clark shall have the power to dispose of the said interest in the said tract of land in her lifetime, by deed or other writing as she may think proper, or by last Will and Testament as she may direct and appoint.

Item 3. I give to my daughter Sarah K. Clark wife of Archibald Clark my interest in a tract of land called Burfords lying in the said County of Buckingham for the sole and separate use of my said daughter, free from the control, debts or contracts of her husband, the said Archibald Clark And the said Sarah K. Clark shall have the power to dispose of the said interest in the said tract of land in her lifetime, by deed or other writing as she may think proper, or by last Will and Testament as she may direct and appoint And in the event that she shall make no such disposition of said interest, the same shall at her death descend and pass to her children living at her death, and the descendants of such of them as may be dead, according to the statute of descents and distributions of the State of Va^a or if the said Sarah K. Clark has survived her said husband and dies intestate.

Gannaway for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said
Jane B. Molloy, dec^d with her said Will annexed in due form.

others.

3^{dly} I give devise and bequeath to my two nephews Zachariah
Robertson and my two nieces Elizabeth and Ann Robertson
my estate to be equally divided between them by
