

I James A. Wright of the County of Buckingham knowing the uncertainty of life do constitute and make this my last Will and Testament as follows to wit Item 1st I direct that all my just debts shall be paid Item 2nd After the payment of my just debts I give to my wife during her life all my estate both real and personal subject to a modification hereafter to be mentioned Item 3. I direct my Executor hereafter to be named to sell all my personal effects except such as may be needed by my wife for her own use. Item 4. I give unto my daughter Ann E. Garnett my home tract snaking the second branch westward from the public road the starting point and thence in a straight line to Millis River at the mouth of Buck and Doe Creek Item 5. I give to my grand daughter Mary E. McCraw the remainder of the Woodbridge tract starting upon the western line of the part given to A. E. Garnett and extending out to a line already chopped off for J. T. Wright Item 6. I appoint my son in law J. M. Garnett & my nephew W. B. Spencer my Executors with full power to contol all my estate both real and personal; to sell any thing or nothing as they may think best and devise they shall not be required to give security As witness my hand and seal this 25 day of April 1889.
