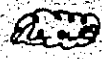


Teste: P. A. Forbes C. B. C.

Buckingham County and State of Virginia February 4th 1893
I, John H. Bradley of said County & State being of sound mind and disposing memory, and feeling assured of the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make and publish this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all others (if any) made by me. After the payment of all debts for funeral expenses &c. I bequeath to my Grand Daughter Etta W. Camden the place I now reside containing one hundred acres, more or less. I also bequeath to my Grand Daughter Rosa Nichols fifty acres of land lying West of the home place. In testimony whereof I set my hand & affix my seal in the presence of two witnesses on the day & date above written.
