

I John Gregory of the County of Buckingham, State of Virginia, knowing that I must soon leave this world, it is my will that after my burial Expenses and just debts are paid, I give to my wife Harriet all of my personal and real Estate during her life, and at her death to my two youngest children Alexander and Kate, and if either one of them should die before my wife, the one surviving to become the sole heir. I also wish my daughter Judy to have a home with my family as long as she remains single, if she marries her right to cease. I have left my other children nothing as I have made advances to them which I consider fully equal to what the two youngest will get.
