

I John Morgan of the County of Buckingham & State of W^{ts} do this day make this my last Will and Testament disannulling all others and hereby confirming this my last Will & Testament.

Examined

Item the 1st I give to my Granddaughter Martha C. Gilliam one neg^{ro} boy Henry Edwards one bed, bedstead & furniture, one folding Table

Item the 2nd I give to my gran children daughter & sons of John D. Gilliam the following property 6 neg^{ro}s Ned Prescy, Sally, Tom, William Henry Clay & Sallys youngest daughter Jennett with the increase of the females to them and thair heirs forever.

Item the 3rd I give to my grandson John James Morgan two neg^{ro} boys James & Pitman one gun & sword to him and his heirs forever.

Item the 4th After giving of special legacies and selling of property after collecting all dues me & paying my just debts I will to Capt James M. Anderson & Richard Anderson in trust for the benefit of my son John P. Morgan & Mary Jane his wife all my property both real and personal during the lives of said John P. Morgan & wife & at thair death I give all my lands to the said John P. Morgan sons now living or may be living at the death of said John P. Morgan & wife to them and thair heirs for ever the neg^{ro}s & allots to Capt. James M. Anderson & Rich^d Anderson in trust for the benefit of John P. Morgan & Mary Jane, his wife during thair lives at thair death I give them to said John P. Morgans children to be equally divided the more sold according I wish soale if a right is made to me or my heirs and the money applies to the payment of John P. Morgans debts, the lands I soale Pleasant Follet there is now a suit to decree a sale of said lands to pay me the balance said Follet is due me if sold I authorize James Anderson & Richard Anderson to purchase said lands at a fair price and to pay for it by selling any

of my property that can best spare from the use of John P. Morgan & wife
be applied to their use or the other lands named in this will and at the death
of said John P. Morgan & wife to be divided between my grand sons as above di-
rected this will was wrote on the twenty fourth day of December 1847 with
my own hand & signed without any one present

At a Court held for Buckingham County, the 11th day of February 1850. This paper pur-
porting to be the last Will and Testament of John Morgan, dec^d with a codicil annexed
was produced in Court in order to be proved, and there being no subscribing witnesses
to the same James N. Forbes and John J. Jordan were sworn and examined, who
severally testifying that they are well acquainted with the hand writing of the testa-
tor and that they verily believed the said Will and codicil & the name thereto sub-
scribed to have been wholly written by the testator's own hand: whereupon the
said Will & Codicil were ordered to be recorded. Sworn to by Edward J.
Williams one of the executors therein named, who entered into and ac-
knowledge bond with security according to law, certificate is granted
him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
