I hereby revoke all former Wills & Testaments at any time made by me.

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, July 11th 1887

This writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Jos. M. Brown, dec^d was this day produced in Court, and there being no subscribing witnesses thereto, John C. Timmer and James M. Ayers were sworn and severally deposed that they are well acquainted with the handwriting of the testator, and truly believe the said writing and the name thereto subscribed, to be wholly written by the testator's own hand. Whereupon the said Writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last Will and Testament of the said Jos. M. Brown, dec^d. And on the motion of Sarah Ann Brown, the Executrix named in said Will, who made oath according to law, and entered into and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of \$600. conditions according to law without security, the testator by her will directing that none should be required, certificate is granted the said Sarah Ann Brown for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form.
