I Junius A. Blay of the County of Buckingham and State
of Virginia, being of lawful age and a sound mind do make this
my last Will and Testament, as follows to wit: I give unto Nicolan
Hamner Cobbs Cox my homestead with two hundred acres of land
attached and all of the furniture in the dwelling belonging to me
(Junious A. Blay). The said land is bounded on the south by M. C.
Elean, on the west by John Hooper and north by Stanley. I give
unto Amandus Allen Cox the remainder of my tract of land in
said County lying east of the dwelling and bounded as follows
on the south by M. C. Elean on the east by Geo. Mowen and north
by A. C. Garrett and Stanley supposed to be about three hundred acres.
I also give unto Amandus all of the furniture belonging to me in
the office in the yard after the death of G. H. Cox. The said place
is to be considered a home for George H. Cox as long as he lives.
I do hereby constitute and appoint the said Geo. H. Cox my Executor
to carry this my Will into effect. Given under my hand and seal this
twenty-ninth of January eighteen hundred and eighty four (Jan 29th 1884)

At a County Court held for Buckingham County August 10th 1885. The last Will and Testament of James A. Clay, did on this day produced in Court and proved by the oath of M. C. Elean and John Hooper, subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded.

I, Bolling Hubbard of the County of Buckingham State of Virginia do make this last Will and Testament.

1st I devise my Executors herein after named out of my estate to pay my funeral expenses and all other debts owing by me at my death.

2nd I devise them to manage my estate according to their best judgment and the net income thereof either to invest in their names as Executors to accumulate for my daughter during her minority, or to pay over the same annually to her guardian as may be best for her. To this end I hereby clothe my Executors with full power and authority to sell and convey all or any part of my real estate whenever they shall deem most advisable and invest the proceeds after my debts are paid in bonds of the City of Lynchburg, or such other safe bonds as may be ordered by Court in their names as Executors and I hereby devise my real estate to my said Executors upon the trusts declared in this Will.

3rd After my debts are paid, I devise and bequeath all the rest of my estate real and personal to my daughter Felicia and direct my Executors to deliver over the same to her, to her sole
