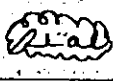

Bolling, whom I do hereby constitute and appoint executor to this my last will and testament - pay my burial expences and all my other just debts - with such money as there may be on hand and coming to me or the sale of such property that can be disposed of - and after all my just debts shall have been paid - that the residue of my estate of every description - personal and real - I leave by this my last will, in the possession and control of my beloved wife Amanda C. Bolling as a support for her during her life time - or her widow hood - and at the death of my wife - that my real estate be disposed of as follows - namely I give and devise to my youngest son Ivanhoe A. Bolling and his heirs - the mansion house and one hundred and thirty two acres of land - lying east of a pond and North of the road leading to the dwelling house - I give and devise to my son Alexander M. Bolling and his heirs - One hundred acres of land to be cut off in such way as to give water, &c. The residue of my real estate I give and devise to my five other children and their heirs equally, share, and share alike as to quality and quantity - namely my daughter Lallie P. Ford and her heirs - my son Phillip A. Bolling and his heirs - my daughter Louisa S. Tolbot and her heirs - my daughter Florence C. McCulloch and her heirs - and my daughter Virginia A. Skidmore and her heirs. In witness whereof I Lemas Bolling the testator have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this twenty eight day of December One thousand eight

thirty two acres of land - lying east of a pond and North of the road leading to the dwelling house - I give and devise to my son Alexander M. Bolling and his heirs - One hundred acres of land to be cut off in such way as to give water &c.
