1st I desire all my just debts shall be paid

2^d I give, bequeath and dispose thereof as follows my real and personal property all of which I do give and devise and bequeath the same unto my nephew Luccan W Hill

And I hereby nominate and appoint my said nephew Luccan W Hill sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made. And I do declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, February 13th 1882
This paper writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Martha A Hill dec^d was this day produced in Court and proved by the oaths of V R Brook and Thomas H Ford subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Luccan W Hill the Executor named in said Will, who made oath thereto, and with Thomas B Norvell, his security, entered into and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of \$100 payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia, and conditions according to law, certificate is granted the said Executor, for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
