Given under my hand and seal this the 20th day of April 1868

At a County Court held for Buckingham County April 14th 1879. This last Will and Testament of Martha Gutherie, dau^r, dated the 20th day of April 1868, and attested by W^m S Wiso and P J Garrett, was this day produced in open Court, and offered for probat by W^m S Wiso the Executor therein named: and the said W^m S Wiso, one of the subscribing witnesses being duly sworn and Examined, testifies that on the 20th day of April 1868 the said Martha Gutherie duly made signed and acknowledged the said last Will and Testament in the presence of the said W^m S Wiso and P J Garrett who were then both present, and who at the request of the said Martha Gutherie and in her presence, and in the presence of each other, then and there subscribed their names to the said Will as witnesses thereto. And the said W^m S Wiso further testifies that the said Martha Gutherie when the said Will was Executed and witnessed as aforesaid, was of sound and disposing mind and memory, and that P J Garrett the other of said subscribing witnesses is not a resident of Virginia. And the Court considering the said Will fully proved

and establish the order the same to be recorded in the last Will and Testament of Martha Guthrie dec'd late of the County of Buckingham

I, Nancy Harris of the County of Buckingham and State of Virginia being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament.

First I devise that all of my just debts shall be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as may be convenient.

Second. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughters Elizabeth A. Foster, Martha S. Smith and Fannie T. England the following property, my share of the debts due to the estate of my deceased son Geo. R. Harris, consisting of a bond due by Virginia Scruggs of \$ — a bond due by Alfred Wade of \$ — a bond due by Jas. A. Harris of \$ — and a bond due by Frank Maxey of \$ — also a claim now in suit due to me from Winfree's executor of \$578.50.

I also give and devise to my beloved daughters before mentioned all of my interest in the real estate belonging to my said deceased son Geo. R. Harris. And I do give bequeath and devise all of my other property of every description however devised to my said daughters before mentioned to them and their heirs forever.
