Mt Ida in the County of Buckingham and State of Va. being in
ill health but sound mind and memory do make this as my
last will and testament.

I direct that all of my personal property except such as is
in the house be sold as soon as it can be done consistently with
with existing contracts, and after the payment of my just debts
be equally divided among my children, Thomas S. Mildred J.,
Langhorne, Meredith, Andrew, Bessie T. Mattie M., James, and
Dabney.

I give the guardianship of such of such of my children
as shall be under twenty one years of age, at the time of my death
to my son Meredith Leitch during their respective minorities.

I nominate and appoint my son Meredith Leitch Ex-
ecutor of this my last Will and Testament and request that
he be allowed to qualify as such without giving security.

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, May 9th
1892. This writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Martha
S. Leitch, dec^d, was this day produced in Court and there being no
objection entered to the said Will, Thomas S. Leitch and J. D. Rogers were
sworn and solemnly affirmed that they are well acquainted with the hand-

writing of the said Martha S. Litch, dec^d and only being that the said Will and the signature thereto subscribed are wholly in the handwriting of the said Martha S. Litch, dec^d. Whereupon the same is ordered to be recorded as the true last Will and Testament of the said Martha S. Litch, dec^d. And on the motion of Meredith Litch, the Executor named in said Will who made oath as the law directs, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$160.00, conditioned according to law without sureties, the Testator, by her will, directing that some should be assigned certificate is granted the said Meredith Litch for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Shaw, for and during her natural life, for her sole and separate use and benefit, all my real estate in the village of Maysville, and adjoining said village, bought by me of my father's estate, consisting of two lots of land, with the buildings and appurtenances thereto, belonging, one known as lot No. 16, and the other adjoining the first, and containing one and one half acres more or less, and at the death of the said Mary E. Shaw
