3^{rdly} I give devise and bequeath to my two nephews Zachariah and George Robertson and my two nieces Elizabeth and Ann Robertson the remainder of my real estate to be equally divided between them lying on Muddy Creek and bounded by the lands of Estate of Robert Bransford est of Henry Tucker Peter Toney and others.

4th It is my wish and desire that the whole of my estate shall contribute equally to the support and maintenance of my said nephew Geo Robertson should that portion given him not be sufficient to do so. Should the said Geo Robertson die leaving one or more of my last mentioned legates to wit Zachariah Elizabeth or Ann Robertson then it is my wish that his portion shall be equally divided between them.

5th Such personal effects that I may leave if any, not distributed I wish sold and the proceeds divided equally between my nephews and nieces above mentioned in this my Will.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my two nephews Geo H Winfrey and Zachariah Robertson my executors.
