At a County Court held for Buckingham County, July 11th 1881, this paper writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of William Woodall, dec^d, was then day produced in Court, and sworn by the oath of James H. Rounton, a subscribing witness thereto, and E. J. Gilliam, the other subscribing witness having died. J. H. Rounton was sworn and deposes that he is well acquainted with the handwriting of the said E. J. Gilliam, and that his signature to said Will was written by the said E. J. Gilliam's own hand. Thereupon the said Will is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Arthur C. Bayly, the executor named in said Will, who made oath thereto as the law directs, and with James H. Rounton, his security, enters into and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of \$150 conditions according to law, (security sworn to justify,) certificate is granted the said executor for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
